Muslim Ummah of North America Condemns the Attempted New York City Terror Attack

(NEW YORK, NY, December 11, 2017) – The Muslim Ummah of North America (MUNA) condemns the attempted pipe bomb attack in New York City and prays for quick recovery of the people injured in the incident.

Today we have learned that a man allegedly tried to detonate a homemade pipe bomb in a New York City Subway platform, injuring himself and four others. We have also learned that the man has been identified as a Muslim immigrant of Bangladesh descent.

MUNA stands firm against all forms of violence by any group regardless of religious affiliation, creed, color, or national origin. The President of MUNA, Imam Delwar Hossain, has said "MUNA condemns any act of violence by such individuals or groups who have no regards to the sanctity of human life. We commend the first responders and NYPD for quickly containing the situation and keeping our community safe. MUNA also urges, our elected officials and community leaders to stand firmly against bigotry and hatred against any ethnic or religious community."

MUNA implores the Muslim community to be vigilant and report any suspicious activities to the law enforcement authorities.
